



## MOVING TOWARDS OUTSTANDING

The experience of schools that have already been inspected under the new Ofsted framework has highlighted the crucial role of team leaders and governors in both developing outstanding practices and in successfully evidencing this during inspection.

### ***The implications of the new Ofsted criteria for school teams*** - Tuesday 21 February

*This session will explore in detail what the Ofsted grade descriptor for outstanding means for schools. It will also provide a practical opportunity for team leaders and governors to consider what they need to do to secure 'outstanding' and the evidence that could be presented.*

### ***Raising standards through monitoring and evaluation*** - Tuesday 6 March

*This session will provide an opportunity to appreciate the role of effective lesson observation and feedback in raising standards within your team / school. This practical session will look at what you need to do before, during and after a lesson observation to ensure it is effective and that it improves teaching and learning and provides robust evidence to inform self-evaluation.*

*We know that school budgets are tight and it is not always possible to release staff during the school day, so the Eastern Leadership Centre (ELC) are offering a series of 4 twilight sessions for staff and governors to keep up-to-date with current issues.*

### ***This term's twilights are on the theme*** ***Moving Towards Outstanding***

Recent announcements from the DfE and Ofsted on performance management and changes to the 'satisfactory' grade mean that inspections on schools to reach good and outstanding judgements have further increased.

### ***Raising standards through effective data analysis*** - Tuesday 28 February

*This session will discuss the importance of data analysis in evidencing your team / schools successes and priorities for development. You will consider the range of evidence and data available to your school's team leaders and governors and how your own data can be most effectively used.*

### ***Supporting your team through change*** - Tuesday 12 March

*This session will provide an opportunity to consider the knowledge and skills needed by team leaders and governors as they support staff through periods of change. It will provide a practical opportunity to look at what makes an effective team, how teams develop and what you can do personally to positively support team members as they work to achieve 'outstanding'.*
